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Introduction

The purpose of this report is to document depositories and locality data of 79 species of North American insects, and give literature citations pertaining to those insect species. The distribution data included herein were gathered from 21 insect collections, including all major collections in museums of the United States and Canada. These institutions are cited on the following page. Institutions surveyed and insect species were selected by the Office of Endangered Species, U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Department of Interior.

Distribution maps included herein reflect only specimens which were identified and available in the surveyed institutions; distribution data found in literature or that which may be present in private collections are not plotted. Maps are coded with symbols to distinguish among locality records for specimens which lacked date of collection information, specimens collected before 1920, specimens collected 1920-1939, specimens collected 1940-1959, and specimens collected 1960-1980. Clustering of symbols around a locality is sometimes necessary, therefore ranges on some maps will appear larger than actually indicated by the data.







specimens collected before 1920





specimens collected 1920 - 1939






