• From the highest prices of around **\$250 per kilogram**, the price to the farmer fell to \$45 in 2004–5 and rebounded to \$160/kg presently. The market appears to be very sensitive to volume – if New Zealand tries to sell much more than 500 tons of frozen velvet, the price falls dramatically. About 1.1 million deer in NZ, each stag producing on average 4.5 kg/annum. Pills for male vigor. China, Korea & Vietnam use extracts also for various medicinal applications.












• Research by Hoffmann-LaRoche, and a studies at the Zoological Society of London (ZSL) concluded that rhino horn has no medical properties. Testing confirmed that "rhino horn, like fingernails, is made of agglutinated hair" and "has no analgesic, anti-inflammatory, anti-spasmolytic nor diuretic properties" and "no bactericidal effect could be found against suppuration and intestinal bacteria."


















Between 2002 and 2007, an average of 19 rhino were poached annually. Lucrative permitted hunting encouraged private reserves to invest in keeping and breeding rhino, thereby guaranteeing their future. Revenue stayed in the country.0.5% of the population (non breeding) were sold to hunters for \$10 million. In June 2008, a moratorium was promulgated which imposed new regulations on the issuing of hunting permits for rhino. Less trade equaled more poaching.

















Total rhino lost due to poaching over the past 4 years.
